• Carl J. Megel Special Education Scholarship - Honoring AFT President Emeritus IFT educators have a unique opportunity to help special education students pursue higher education or career training by sponsoring them for this Special Education Scholarship.

The IFT will award one \$20,000 Megel scholarship (\$5,000 each year for four years) to a deserving high school senior who is enrolled in a special education school, class, or program for students with disabilities. Applicants must be high school seniors who will graduate in 2024.

IFT members who work directly with (or previously worked with) an eligible student must provide a letter of sponsorship for the applicant. (Children of IFT members may also apply)

Robert G. Porter Scholarship - Honoring late AFT Secretary-Treasurer

An applicant must be the son or daughter of a currently employed, active member in good standing of the Illinois Federation of Teachers, of IFT retirees chapter, or of a deceased member in good standing with the Illinois Federation of Teachers at the time of death.

# Each year the Southwest Suburban Federation of Teachers, AFT Local 943, awards two scholarships in the amount of two-thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) each

The applicant must be the child of a currently employed, active member in good standing of Local 943; or the child of a member of Local 943's retiree chapter; or the child of a deceased member who was in good standing at the time of death.

The applicant must be a member of a public high school graduation class and enrolling in a public college or university (including community colleges).

Selection will be made on the basis of five criteria listed below:

- 1. official scores on the ACT/SAT entrance examinations
- 2. class rank, and GPA (1st semester of senior year)
- 3. record of extra-curricular activities and community service
- 4. two (2) letters of reference by members of the staff of the student's high school where he/she is currently enrolled
- 5. a 100-word essay which details future aspirations.

# Students from SWCCCASE Transition Work Program Join AFT Local 943 for a Semester!






# 2024 Union Leadership Institute: Administrator Academy

# **Legislative Update**

"Invest In Kids"

The "Invest in Kids" Scholarship Tax Credit Program will officially come to a close at the start of the new year. Despite the intended plan to sunset, the program has stirred controversy, leading many lawmakers to advocate for its extension in this year's Fall Veto Session. Vouchers reduce funding for public schools by allowing the use of taxpayer public funds for private schools. This program alone has diverted more than \$190 million in tax dollars to hundreds of private schools around the state, while "investors" in this program receive a 75% tax credit on their donation.

We'd like to thank all those who reached out to our legislators by sending postcards and emails, making phone calls, and having 1-on-1 conversations discussing our opposition to this program. In response to the news, IFT President Dan Montgomery released a statement summarizing the focus of our union advocacy: "We will continue to work with our school communities and lawmakers to advocate for equitable educational policies that uplift every child and strengthen our public education system by fully funding it and opposing any voucher or voucher-like programs in the future."
